

KINGS (CONTINUED)

After the death of King Solomon, his son Rehoboam took over and within one year, the kingdom was spilt into two: Israel in the north and Judah in the south. (931 B.C., read **1 Kings 12** for details)

Israel (north) as a kingdom existed for slightly over 200 years, from 931 B.C. to 722 B.C. All her kings were ungodly. Judah (south) existed as a kingdom for less than 350 years, from 931 B.C. to 586 B.C. Some of her kings were godly while others were ungodly.
